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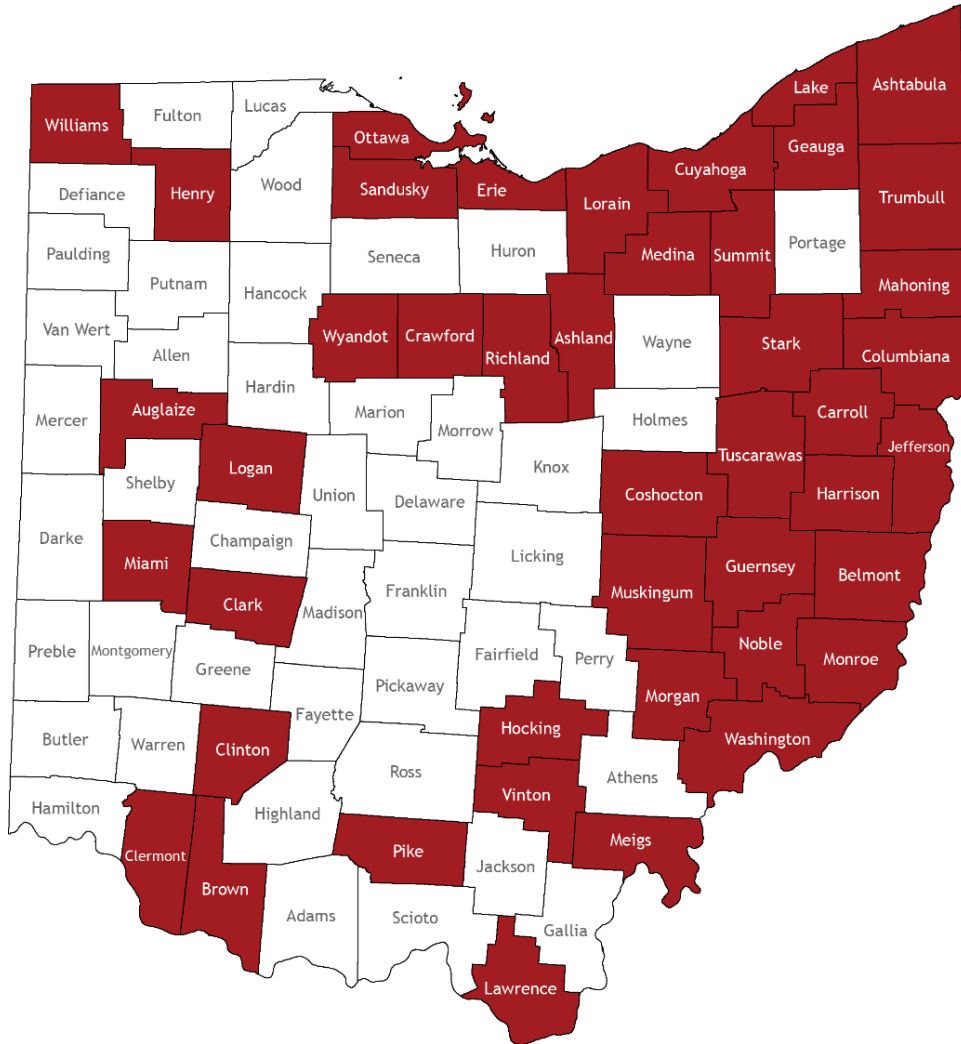

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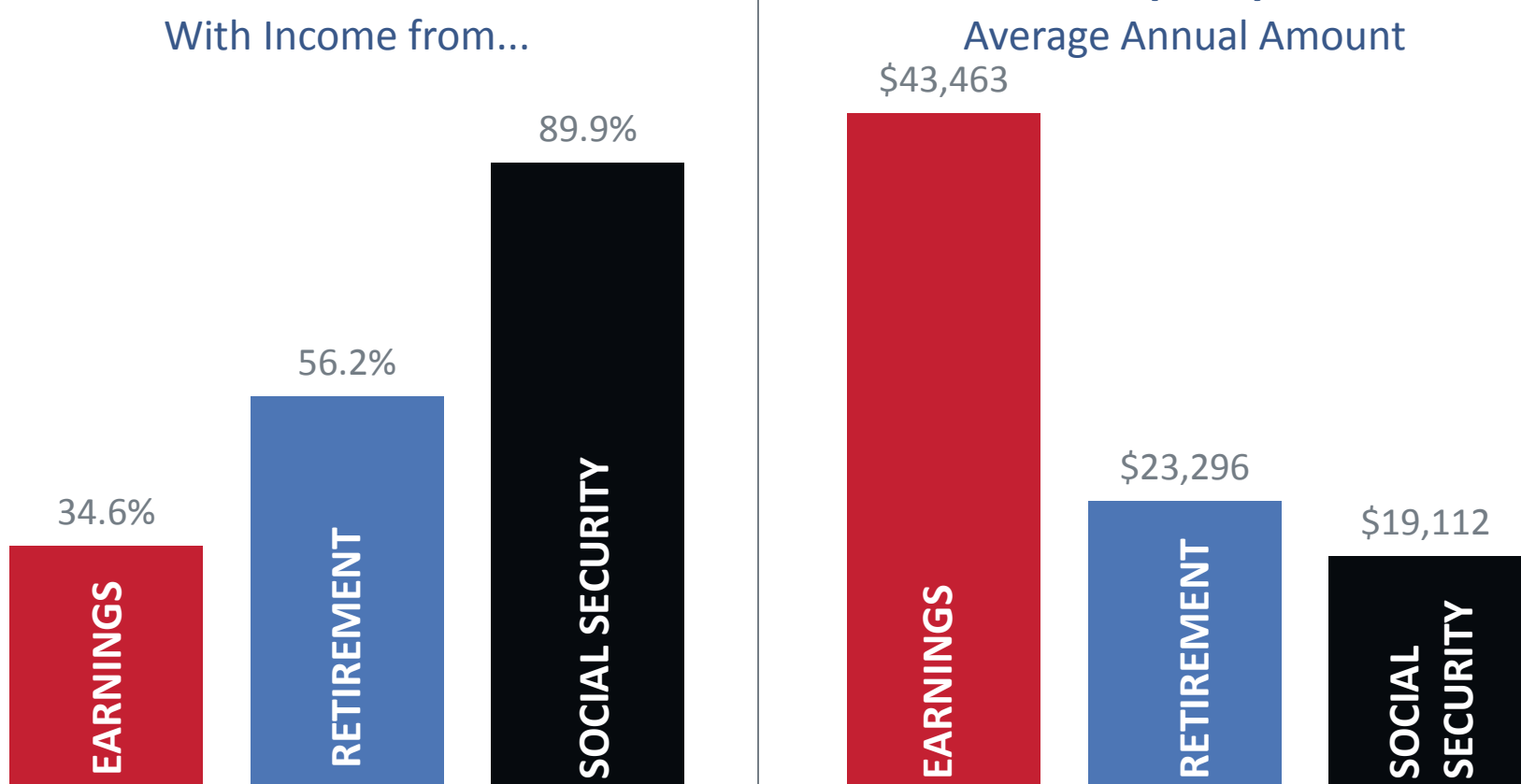
# The older adult population is growing.

## Income in the Past 12 Months, Ohio Older Adult (65+) Households

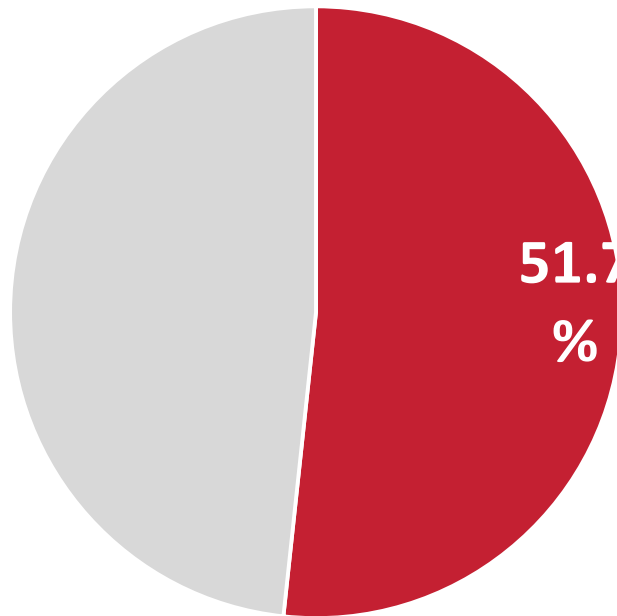

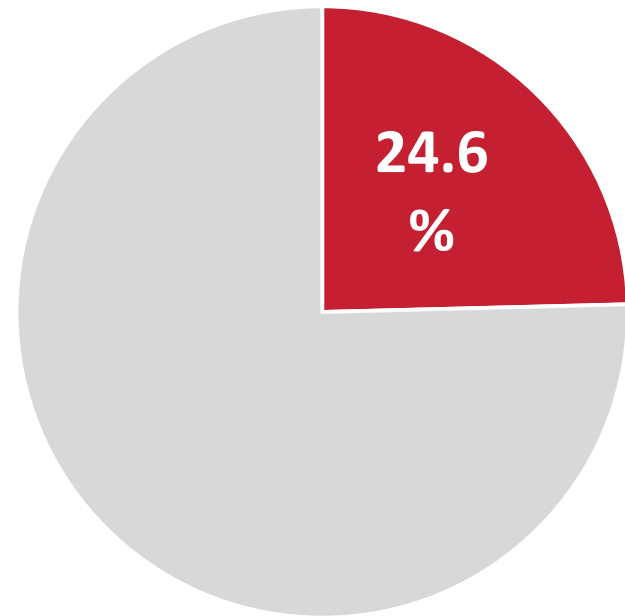
# A greater share of Ohio older adults live in unaffordable housing situations

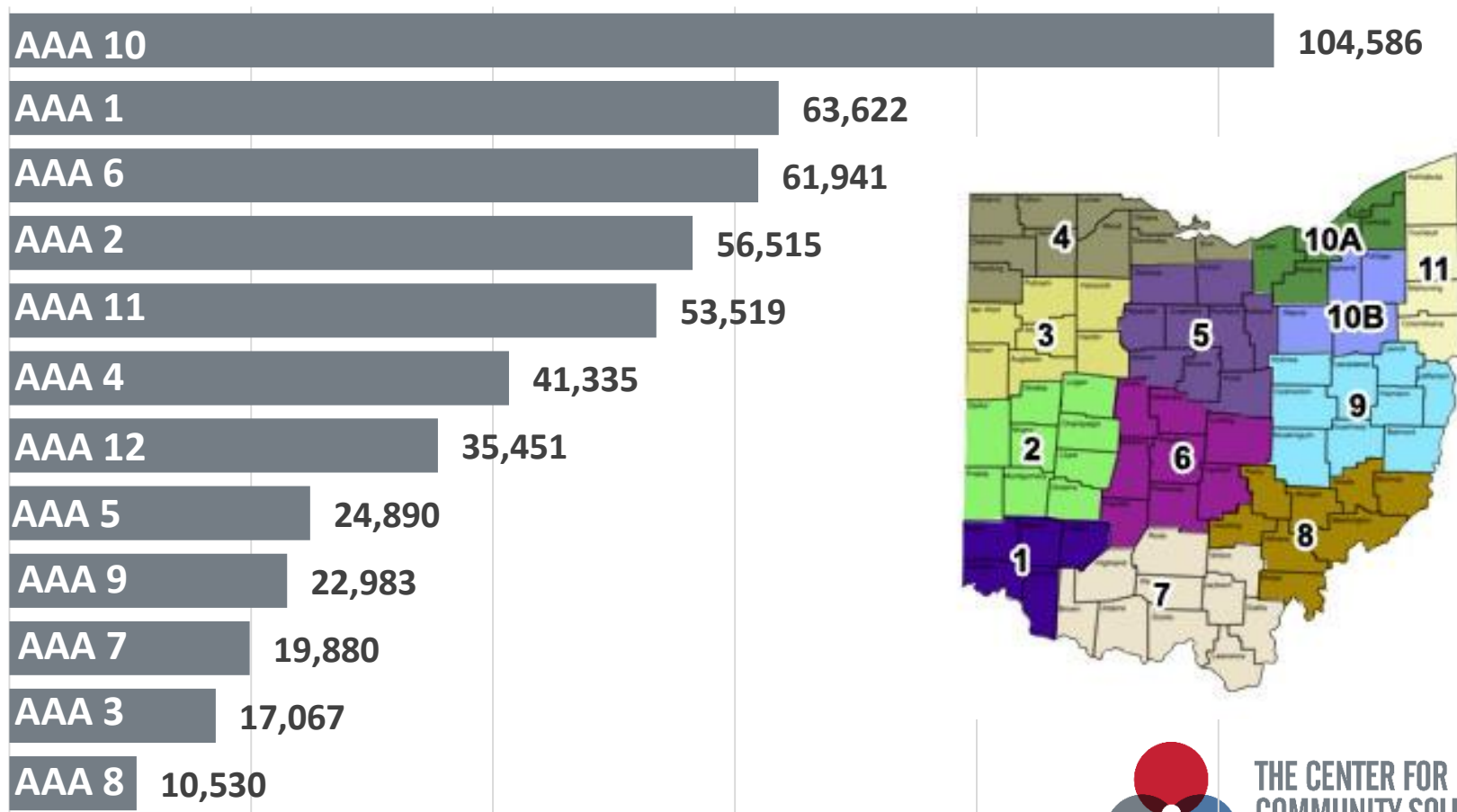

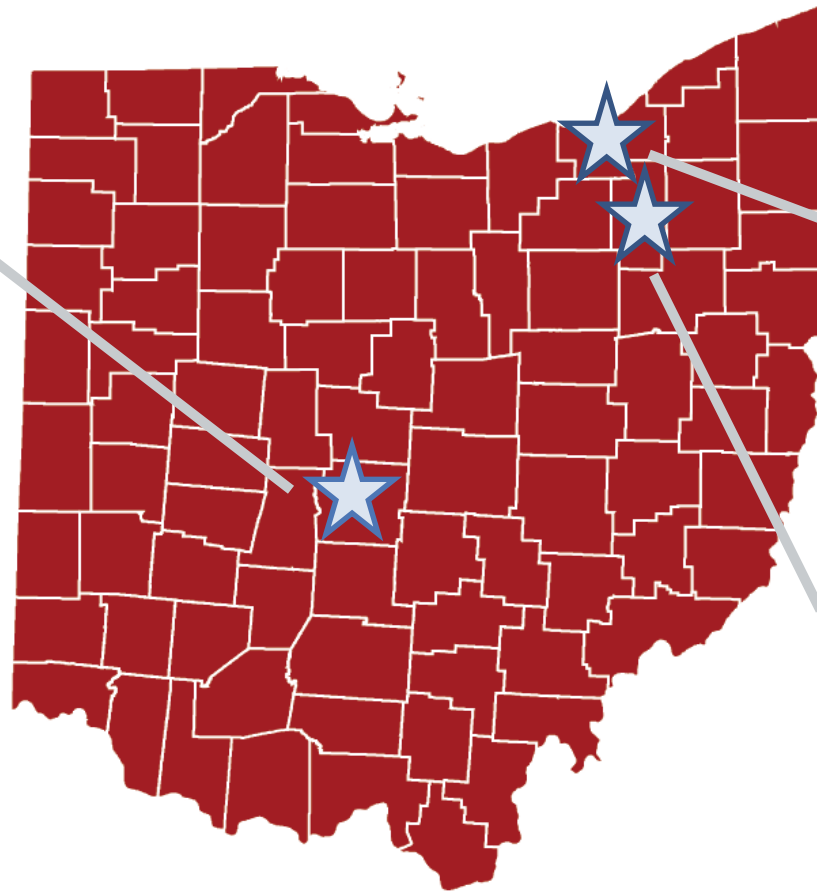


# Community Solutions' surveys cover over 415,000 Ohio older adults

# Looking across the first two surveys, patterns begin to emerge.



Driving predominates, especially for higher income individuals.

Outside home maintenance is a greater challenge than indoor maintenance

Most believe there are negative stereotypes about older adults.

Future planning (long-term care, home modification) is a concern.



# Home-delivered meals are an important, and cost-effective resource for aging in place

**1** home-delivered meal costs 

This means we could provide older Ohioans with **1 month of daily delivered meals** for the same cost as **1 day in a nursing home**.



**475,000 Ohio older adults face the threat of hunger**
