- A. **Provides a** toll free legal hotline to all Ohio residents as well as a website with information on a vast array of assistance programs & legal issues.
- B. **Two examples** of these opportunities are Ohio's Program 60 and Road Scholar Program.
- C. **Charged with** investigating complaints of elder abuse, neglect and exploitation in the State of Ohio. Administered by ODJFS.
- D. **Responds to complaints** from older Consumers of Long Term Care services in Ohio. Attempts to resolve disputes between providers and consumers.
- E. **Links** kinship caregivers to public & private benefits and services.
- F. **Consolidated** assistance with heating and cooling bills. Application process for most consumers is in the fall. Also assistance with telephone costs.
- G. **Available** to all Ohio residents age 60 and over and residents with disabilities. Provides discounts to many goods and services.
- H. **Provides paid** job training and experiences to those age 55 and over whose incomes quality.
- I. **Provides education** to consumers on a variety of topics related to staying healthy.
- J. **Provides a much** needed staple of life to many households and tables.
