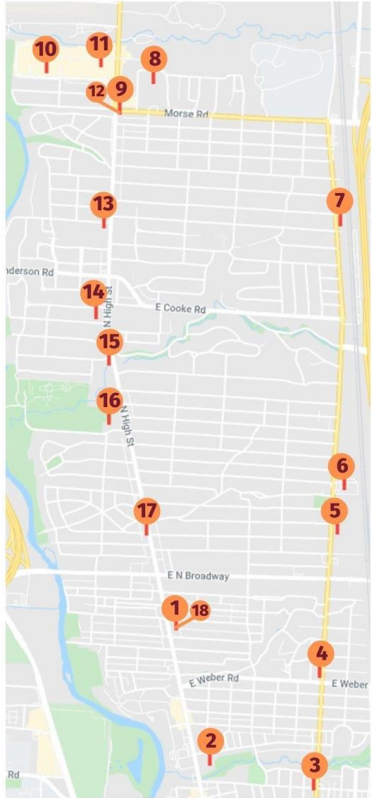


C-Loop Map

- Operates each Tuesday from 10am-4pm.
- Open to anyone in the community, age 50+
- Sign-up online, over the phone, or in person
- Each rider receives a rider card and unique rider number
- Fixed route, with flexible stops.
- In 2022, will pilot two bus loop system

PROGRAM SUMMARY

604

In one year, starting in August 2019, the program provided 604 Lyft rides

46%

46% of rides took members to doctor's appointments. Members also used Lyft to go grocery shopping and run other errands, attend social outings, access social service agencies, get to a job, and even find housing.

80%

80% of participants, who completed an initial survey, noted that they did not have access to a vehicle

73

73 unduplicated individuals used the Lyft service through the Lyfting Villages program

5.9

On average Lyft rides were 5.9 miles. 3595.62 miles were traveled in total, through the Lyfting Villages program

15.4

On average trips lasted 15.4 minutes. The longest trip was 56 minutes.

\$14.65

On average, trips cost \$14.65. The most expensive trip was \$45.72 and allowed a member to visit a relative for the first time in a number of years.

77
