- Most of these programs have been launched at the cost to the AAA for several reasons:
 - Program is tied to a grant with no plan for succession or sunset.
 - Cost of project management
 - Staffing king fully employed staff to take on a new project/program without financial analysis.

Project vs. Program

Project

- Who is managing the Project?
- Are there consultants or contacts from the partnering entity?
- Contracts & Credentials
- In-house or Subcontract?
- Timelines and Training
- Establishing workflows
 - Finance
 - HR
 - Any other department impacted
- Hand off

Program

- Who will be managing the Program
- Training for Managers & Staff
- How are referrals generated/handled?
- Where is the program information documented
- What are the reporting requirements?
- What are staffing requirements and ratios?
- How to maintain and measure quality and contract metrics

Should the AAA accept the Program?

- Funding source/Term of funding
- Contract & KPIs
- Profit margin
- Breakeven
- Return on Investment (ROI)
- Billing & Billable Events
- Sustainability & Sunset Plans

Workflows

If you don't have someone that can facilitate project management, do you have the systems in place to develop the infrastructure and make sure all affected teams know their part?

- Department the new program "lives"
 - Managers-create policies, SOPs
 - Staff-has training and skills to accomplish task for new program
- HR-new job descriptions
- Training-add program to orientation & include any additional modules

Workflows

• Finance

- Labor codes
- Billing information, deliverables, & reconciliation
- Reception
 - Educate all persons answering calls about the new program
 - Include new program as an option in the agency message
- IT
 - Support new programs with email, calendar, & Pingboard
- Data Analytics
 - Support compliance, reporting, & billing

Training, Quality & Compliance

- Agency
 - Annual Training
 - Compliance
 - Data Analytics
- Department
 - Managers
 - How are contractual metrics taught, monitored, shared and met with staff?
 - Staff
 - Are tools or supports in place to facilitate success?
